6. How can we encourage each other, in our community group, to grow in our faith with action? Read Hebrews 10:24. What is God's vision for our community?

Get ready to add to the family.

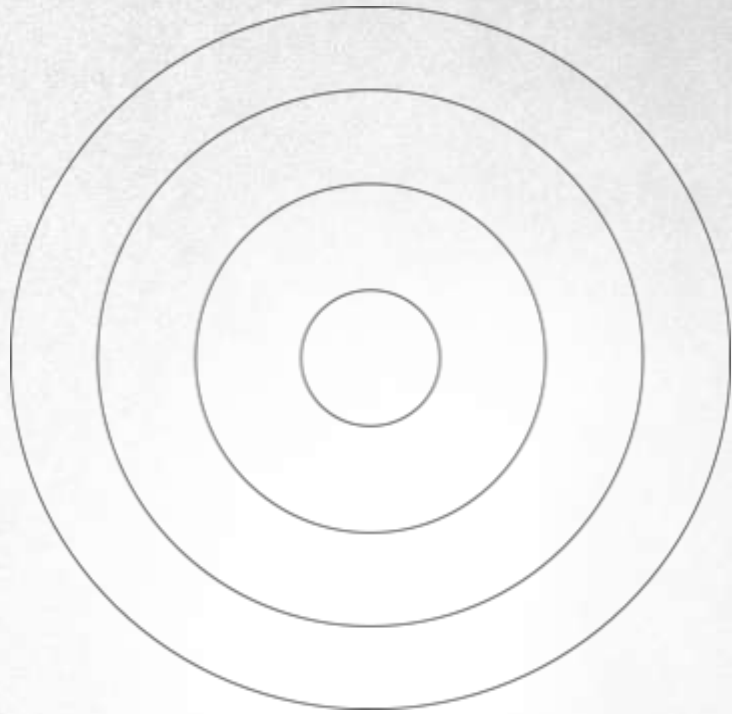
"Be dressed ready for service and keep your lamps burning.."
