

NEXT STEP QUESTIONS

1. Spend seven minutes discussing this week's talk. What was something that resonated with you?
2. How does asking for things in God's name affect what we ask for and how we ask for it?
3. Read Proverbs 3:5-6. What does this tell us about walking with God?
4. Reflect on the names of Jesus shared during the talk. Which names resonated with you and why?
5. This week's talk/discussion was about being in harmony with the Creator that knows what is best for us. What facet of being one with the Father is most difficult for you? Asking in, walking in, or knowing His name?
6. What are some things that you could begin to do today that would "spark joy" and bring yourself into closer harmony with Jesus?

Action Step:

After reflecting on what you can do this week to "spark joy" in your relationship with Jesus—whether that is asking in, walking in, or knowing His name—ask God during your first seven minutes each morning to give you the desire and discipline to move closer into harmony with Him in this one area. At one point during the day, pause and ask God to show you His will in the trials of your day and thank Him for His guidance.
